Subject: Compliance Requirements for Streamlining AICTE Approval Process.

As per the provisions of the AICTE Act, 1987, it is mandatory for institutions offering Technical Courses to obtain AICTE approval as outlined in the *Approval Process Handbook (APH) 2024-27*. Institutions must fulfill the essential and desirable requirements prescribed in Chapter VI of the APH to ensure compliance with the prescribed standards and norms.


However, deficiencies, non-compliance, or errors in the submitted forms often result in delays in the approval process. To streamline the procedure and ensure adherence to norms, institutions seeking AICTE approval must take the necessary steps to implement and monitor the following essential requirements:

1. **Anti-Ragging Measures:** Establish an Anti-Ragging Committee as per AICTE Regulations (01.07.2009) and UGC guidelines.
2. **Internal Committee (IC):** Constitute an IC as per the AICTE Regulations (2016) for gender sensitization, prevention of sexual harassment, and grievance redressal for women employees and students.
3. **SC/ST Committee:** Establish a committee as mandated by the *Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989*.
4. **Grievance Redressal Mechanisms:**
 - o Set up an online grievance redressal mechanism.
 - o Establish a Grievance Redressal Committee within the institution.
 - o Appoint an Ombudsman in accordance with AICTE Regulations (2019 for students; 2021 for faculty/staff).
5. **Institutional Innovation Council (IIC):** Create an ecosystem for innovation and entrepreneurship within the institution.
6. **Facilities for Persons with Disabilities:** Ensure compliance with guidelines for barrier-free environments for physically challenged and elderly individuals, as per prescribed space standards.
7. **Other Essential and Desirable Requirements:** Adhere to clauses 6.53 and 6.54 of the APH 2024-27, respectively.

Institutions are encouraged to comply with all provisions of the Act and regulations to uphold high standards in technical education, foster a resilient educational ecosystem, and enable the timely processing of approval applications.

Any deficiencies identified in the report must be promptly addressed. To facilitate this, the portal will be open for updating and correcting records from **14.01.2025 to 20.01.2025**.
